### **Upcoming events:**

#### Staff news:

1. The Michigan Library Association Spring Conference is in Frankenmuth in April and Amy, Hannah and Ashlynn have applied for "continuing education stipends" to enable us to attend. Due to the rapidly changing federal funding rules, the Library of Michigan is carefully reviewing all current grants to see if they can continue to provide funds. Therefore, we are still awaiting the results of the stipend requests before reserving our spots for the conference.

#### **Building Maintenance and Grounds:**

1. DeMar Electric has ordered the new lights for above the front desk. They will set a date to do the work after the items have shipped. The funds for this project were made possible by the Library's Maintenance Endowment Fund held at the Midland Area Community Foundation.

## Finances, Grants & Donations:

- 1. The library was awarded a grant from the Midland Area Community Foundation for \$6,500 to replace the Public Access Computers, to enable us to upgrade to Windows 11
- 2. The library was able to use MMLC Tech & Innovation Grant funds to purchase a "ThermalStrike Ranger Bed Bug Heater" to have on hand, just in case the need arises. This specialized heater will "cook" library items (books, magazines, etc.) to kill bed bugs, lice, moths and other insects.
